

<u>Mission/Purpose:</u> Our goal is to open our pantry and our hearts twice a month – with dignity, respect and love – and provide a two-to three-day emergency supply of food to those in need.

When to Get Food: Our pantry is open on the second and fourth Saturdays, from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. Shoppers can visit once or twice per month, depending on individual need.

<u>How to Get Food:</u> Each time shoppers visit, we ask that they bring legal identification (driver's license or state ID) AND a piece of mail (junk mail is fine) for each adult member of their household. For children, the preferred form of identification is a Forward card for each child.

<u>How to Give Food:</u> We much appreciate and depend on food drives, food donations, monetary donations, and bequests from fellow parishioners and other benefactors.

- **Food donations** may be made through food baskets in the worship spaces at St. Catherine and St. Sebastian Parishes, or by calling Rob Shelledy 414-477-3954.
- **Permanent requests** include canned tuna, canned chicken, macaroni & cheese, raw beans (pinto, black, kidney), raw white rice, pasta (all shapes/sizes), canned pork & beans, canned chili (meat or meatless), boxed cereal, oatmeal, pancake mix, canned fruit (mandarin oranges, fruit cocktail, applesauce), and canned vegetables (cut green beans, corn, tomatoes, white or sweet potatoes)

How to Help:

- **Volunteers** are needed to sort food, shelve food, shop, pick up food donations, staff the pantry, and other tasks. Contact Jane Kornburger 414-445-5115.
- Monetary donations may be made by check payable to St. Catherine Parish, attention Food Pantry, 5101 W. Center, Milwaukee, WI 53210


Who We Serve: Our neighborhood zip codes include 53208, 53209, 53210, 53216, 53218.
